



How to install a desktop font

OPEN THE .ZIP FILE

Windows

If you're using Windows XP or later, right-click the .zip archive and select "Extract All," which will create a new folder containing your fonts in the location of your choice.

Macintosh

Double click on the file, and it will open the folder and display all the fonts.

INSTALL THE FONT

Windows

To activate a font on any version of Windows, navigate to *Computer ► Local Disk (C:) ► Windows ► Fonts*. Locate the folder with the font files in it, and drag the files into the "Font" folder.

Macintosh

To activate a font on a Macintosh computer, install it using Font Book, Apple's font management software. Launch Font Book from your Applications folder, and drag the font files from the font folder you downloaded into the middle pane labeled "Font."

Alternatively, double click on each of the font files you downloaded. A pop up screen showing the font should come up. Click on the "Install Font" button in the bottom right corner, and the font will install through the Font Book application.
